Thomas Navarro

Thomas Navarro's two year long struggle to survive brain cancer came to an end on November 19, 2001 when the six-year old child died in Houston, Texas. During the first eighteen months after Thomas' diagnosis, in September 1999, his family's efforts to get him access to alternative treatments resulted in major national publicity, becoming the most compelling and heart-wrenching individual example of the search for medical freedom in more than two decades. Thomas and his parents James and Donna won considerable political support, too - which led to freedom of choice legislation, the "[Thomas Navarro FDA Patient Rights Act](#)," being introduced in the House of Representatives on February 16, 2000.

Dr. Stanislaw Burzynski, MD, PH.D - Burzynski Clinic, Burzynski Research Institute, Houston

Featured in the film, Stanislaw R. Burzynski, M.D., Ph.D., internationally recognized and controversial physician and biochemist-researcher who pioneered the development and use of biologically active peptides in diagnosing, preventing and treating cancer, since 1967. He is also the president of the [Burzynski Research Institute](#), where he continues to pursue scientific research on Antineoplastons.
